The vision statement of God

Every service ends with **communion** in order to bring every lesson back to Christ. This is a great time to repent and reflect.

• We offer **prayer** for anyone who may need to confess or ask for spiritual help.

We always invite new or non-Believers to ask a pastor questions and move forward.

THE BEST PROBLEM

God is really blessing our church

We're seeing rapid growth in all 4 campuses, but this campus is getting tight, and our greatest concern is that facilities or parking prohibit people from hearing the gospel.

We had over 6800 people between our campuses last week, but over 5500 of them were in Murfreesboro.

Maximizing every inch of our property

We have under 100,000 square feet for this campus, and we use virtually every inch every day of the week. We also have limited parking on site, so we use other areas.

 We've expanded the sanctuary, added chairs, asked people to consider Sat. 7 pm, and we're finetuning our Parking Team.

Planting more churches

- We have 3 other campuses (Cannon, Bedford, and Coffee counties) that one can attend. We are also
 praying about a 2nd Rutherford campus.
- Growth always seems to outpace our resources. Please be patient with us as we train up leaders and save proper finances.

FINANCES

How we steward your giving

- Total for all campuses: 2022 Income (\$9,873,855), 2023 Budget (\$9,900,000)
- Administration (\$3,273,315 33%) Salaries and benefits
- MIT Program (\$278,732) Salaries and benefits
- Other Administration (\$263,628) Sheriff, police, CPA, maintenance, etc.
- Ministry expenses (\$634,244)
- Operating costs (\$422,900)
- Saving (\$1,000,000)
- Repairing things at campuses (\$?) This will come from savings if needed.

Financial hurdles

- Creating more parking: roughly \$100,000 to build out the Student Center side.
- Creating more space: We're running out of space here (2nd campus or surrounding land).
- Planting more churches: Since we refuse to take out a loan, we want to have the money in the bank to pay cash for space.

Financial commitment to the vision

I don't know who gives at this church. Whether one believes tithing is an NT thing or not, it's impossible
to argue that we shouldn't financially contribute to the mission of the church.

If we're going to advance the gospel, it will take not only time and effort but also a financial commitment.

MAKING DISCIPLES

Prayer

 We want to make prayer more of an emphasis in our church through Life Groups, the Prayer Team, and prayer during services.

Worship Nights

 We are only doing two Worship Nights this year because of the size. We want to keep these excellent and God-honoring.

Baptisms and being Evangelists

We want to make sure that we're still diligently building relationships with non-Believers and introducing them to Jesus. We pray that 50% of our growth results in baptisms in 2023.

We don't want to become complacent and lose our passion for reaching all kinds of people!
 In a time when Christianity is declining...

...we want to serve our city, help others serve their cities, see more people come to know Jesus, and grow current Believers deeper in their faith.

 We have no desire to make our church or anyone in it famous. Our desire is to help illuminate the truth to anyone seeking

What now?

- Commit to being at church, praying, listening to God, reading the Word, and obeying what the Bible says.
- Commit to the discipleship process. It works.
- Please be patient with us as we do our best to navigate rapid growth and limited resources.

If we're to reach our city and beyond

- We need to be **praying** for our city and for the gospel to advance in it.
