 GOOD PROBLEMS

MASSIVE GROWTH AT ALL CAMPUSES
In August 2022, we averaged 4,732 in Boro and 5,515 in all campuses.

In August 2023, we averaged 6,430 in Boro and 7,835 in all campuses (42% growth).

THE GROWTH IS A BLESSING AND AN OBSTACLE

• Space: ECCO Kids is averaging almost 1,600 kids just in Boro. We need to be creative and make more use of our limited space. Students are also growing and using every inch of their space.

Parking: We're trying to use our surroundings efficiently and transport people comfortably.
VOLUNTEERS/SERVING

Though we have an amazing volunteer base, the rapid growth has outpaced people serving in the church (Volunteer Interest Meeting!).

It usually takes about six months for someone to commit to giving. Because of growth, our giving is less than what it should be.
