RAPID GROWTH

MASSIVE GROWTH AT ALL CAMPUSES

We experienced 35% growth in 2023, averaging 7,412. This campus has experienced **73% growth** since December, with our numbers last weekend being 360 people at this campus and about **9,100 across all campuses.**

12 people have been baptized in 2024 in the Ville and 391 across all campuses.

WHY IS GOD BLESSING THIS CHURCH?

We have seen rapid growth in the last 14 years because we do expository teaching, give a large portion of our income away, are involved in the community, **welcome all people**, and are **simple** and **authentic**.

• We are simply using biblical principles to make disciples, baptize, and teach (Matthew 28). CREATING OPPORTUNITIES TO HEAR THE GOSPEL

We have made changes (buildouts and new team positions) that allowed us to do more and prepare for growth. We launched Encounter, Authentic Discipleship, Weekday Kids, and 5000.

 We have done all we can to provide space for the gospel to be heard, but space in the sanctuary and parking continues to be a problem.

IT'S A GOOD PROBLEM

The remedy for space in the sanctuary is Saturday services. We currently need 60–70 volunteers serving on Sunday, and to launch Saturday services **we will need to double that number.**

We have maximized the use of the BCLA lot, but it is still unsafe to cross 41A. We are actively
working toward a solution (crossing guard, lot behind offices, bus).

MISSIONS

OUR STATE AND NATION

- Murfreesboro (2009), Cannon County (2017), Shelbyville (2021), Tullahoma (2022), and M.I.T.
- We support 7 different missionaries and ministries domestically: Mosaico Church (Smyrna, TN), Hope Church (Seaford, DE), City Church (Albany, NY), Garden City Church (Beverly, MA), New Life Church (Leominster, MA) and Young Life (USA).

OUR WORLD

We support 11 different missionaries and ministries internationally: King's Castle (El Salvador); EEM (Eastern Europe); Grandi Nan Nou Home (Haiti-Shelby and Jameson Toyo); Light and Life Ministries (Haiti); First Priority (World); Impact Africa (Ashley); Instruments of Joy (World); Paracletes (Thailand-Dylan and Rachel).

WE ARE ACTS 1:8 MISSIONAL

We have two trips so far this year (El Salvador and a Student VBS trip to Garden City Church in Beverly, MA).

 At the end of this month, we have another El Salvador trip, and in October we will have our pilot trip to Egypt. That makes four trips this year with seven trips already planned for 2025.

GOING DEEPER

We are currently exploring opportunities in Guatemala and Costa Rica. We hope to explore opportunities in Europe and here in our nation.

 Though we are open and actively looking at these new areas, our desire is not just to add more partners but to go deeper with the ones we have.

FINANCES: HOW WE STEWARD YOUR GIVING IT ALL BELONGS TO GOD

A steward is someone who manages another's property or financial affairs, meaning we are managers of God's possessions.

As good stewards, we remember that we do not own what we have. We have been entrusted to
manage God's property in this life, and one day we will answer for how we handled His property.

- Budget: \$13,000,000; Expenses: \$14,457,784; Projected Income: \$17,145,038
- Outreach & Benevolence: \$3,892,627 30% of Budget compared to a 10% national average.
- Our team earns 34% of our budget compared to a 55% national average.
- Full and part-time salaries for all campuses: \$4,454,388 (34%); Taxes: \$233,000; Health Benefits: \$1,300,000; M.I.T.: \$152,000
- Outside CPA: \$17,314
- Police and Sheriff Dept.: \$91,786 (present during all services in Boro and for directing traffic on 41a here in the Ville)

CAMPUS BUDGET BREAKDOWN PLUS NETWORK

- Murfreesboro: \$9,644,539 + \$324,385 = \$9,968,924
- Cannon County: \$781,064 + \$324,385 = \$1,105,449
- Shelbyville: \$426,475 + \$324,385 = \$750,860
- Tullahoma: \$825,801 + \$324,385 = **\$1,150,186**

THE EXPERIENCE COMMUNITY SHELBYVILLE

- Operating Costs: \$41,000 (utilities and maintenance); Benevolence: \$70,557; Ministry Expenses: \$70,748; Salaries: \$216,623; Benefits: \$66,300; Buildouts and Repairs: \$96,000; Mortgage (paid off this year): \$595,805
- 2024 Actual Budget/Expenses: \$1,157,033

- 2024 Budget: \$750,861 (with shared Network Expenses)
- 2024 Projected Giving: \$602,577
- Difference: -\$148,284
 - This amount is what it will take to not only meet the needs of one campus but also share the load as one church.

HOW ARE WE DOING?

The average giving per person was \$2,340 for 14,000 churches surveyed in America. Giving has increased by about \$500 per person this year with a campus average of \$1,995.53.

 The congregation is giving better across all campuses, and we are only \$345 per person away from the average, so we must continue in obedience and trust.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO THE VISION

I do not know who gives at this church. Whether one believes tithing is a NT thing or not, it is impossible to argue that Christians should not financially contribute to the mission of the church.

 If we're going to advance the gospel, it will take not only time and effort but also a financial commitment.

WE ARE TRYING TO ADVANCE THE GOSPEL

We do not advertise or use gimmicks to grow. **We will not** waste money on frivolous or meaningless comforts. **We will** strive to be as frugal as possible and to be the most benevolent church we know how to be.

We will continue to be transparent and honest to earn your trust, but it is up to you to be obedient.

BIBLICAL GIVING

WHAT ARE TITHES AND OFFERINGS?

Tithing is the biblical action of giving a tenth of one's "first fruits" to the work of the ministry.

- Offerings are when we give to the church or community beyond tithes.
- Giving financially to nonprofits is considered an offering above and beyond what we should be contributing to the church.
- Proverbs 3:9–10
- Malachi 3:8–10

TITHING IN THE NT?

The command to give exactly 10% is not explicitly taught in the NT, though Jesus alludes to it in Matthew 23:23.

- The NT takes it up a notch and asks us to practice generosity because Christ has been generous
 to us. Compared to Jesus, who gave us everything, 10% is a good standard of generosity.
- 2 Corinthians 8:2–4

WHERE IS OUR TREASURE?

Our lives are "like vapor" (James 4:14) compared to eternity, and we are to use our limited time to **store up treasures in heaven** (Matthew 6:19–24).

 The location of our treasures is key because our heart follows our treasures (Matthew 6:21). If we are content storing up earthly treasures, then our hearts cannot be on heavenly things.

HOW ARE WE DOING?

IT'S ALL FOR HIS GLORY! We are making a real difference, and the evidence is all around us!

 If you are regularly attending services, plugged into the Discipleship Process, giving, and serving, then you have actively been a part of authentically sharing Jesus with our community. If we are obedient, God will continue to use us to transform lives!

JUST A FEW TANGIBLE "WINS"

So far this year, \$10,456 has gone into our schools and nonprofits supporting students and teachers.

- 1,692 items were collected and donated to United Way's "Stuff the Bus" in July.
- We provided classroom needs for 10 different projects through Donors Choose.
- We helped 26 children through CarePortal.

WE CANNOT LET UP NOW!

- We have done nothing to manufacture the growth we see, so God must be making it happen.
 Since that is the case, we must continue in what has gotten us to this point.
- Make church a priority, get involved in our Discipleship Process, and get plugged in to community (Intro to LG at 1:00 pm)!
- Invest in your personal relationship with Jesus through praying, reading, listening, and obeying. This is not something we can do for you!
- There's no gimmick or trick to seeing lives changed—it is just consistent dedication to a relationship with Christ.
- Prayerfully consider tithing. The team will not financially benefit, our salary percentages will not
 go up, and we will not use your giving for foolish and decadent means. It will be used to serve
 our city and advance the gospel.
