THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE

SEPTEMBER 29TH, 2024 // REVELATION

FIFTH TRUMPET (REVELATION 9:1-6) WARNINGS GIVE WAY TO WOES

What took place previously with the first four trumpets were warnings for humanity, but the next three trumpets are curses (woes) against humanity.

 Ch. 8 ended with an angel high above, crying out for people to repent because the remaining trumpets will be more severe and directly affect humanity.

"A STAR THAT HAD FALLEN FROM HEAVEN"

The star that fell from heaven is an angel who has been given the key to unlock the abyss and release demonic forces onto the earth. Some scholars believe this "fallen star" is Satan, the leader of all fallen angels.

• It is possible this is the same angel holding the key to the abyss that seizes Satan and binds him for 1,000 years (20:1–2).

"THEN LOCUSTS CAME OUT OF THE SMOKE"

When the abyss is unlocked and opened, smoke rises like that of a great furnace so the sun and sky are darkened.

John witnesses a new terror coming from the smoke and filling the sky. John sees demons taking
on a visible form resembling locusts, swarming out of the abyss to plague the earth.

GOD GIVES POWER AND PERMISSION

It appears that these demons are a special class of **evil spirits that have been under God's lock and key** (Jude 1:6) until this time and will be unleashed to accomplish His will.

 These demons are "given" the power to inflict severe pain (pain like that of a scorpion on earth) on people for five months.

THIS ONLY AFFECTS THE UNSAVED

The demons were not permitted to kill or to harm the earth but were given power and authority to inflict pain only on those "who do not have God's seal on their foreheads."

 This pain will be so severe that those tormented by the demons "will seek death and will not find it; they will long to die, but death will flee from them."

THE TORMENT IS A FORETASTE OF HELL

There will be those who during this torment will seek death and not God. The tormented will long for a way out, but even **death for the unrepentant is not a release from wrath.**

God is allowing these five months of torment as an opportunity to repent; to experience five
months of Hell on earth to be spared from an eternity in Hell.

THE FIRST WOE IS COMPLETE (REVELATION 9:7-12) JOHN'S DESCRIPTION OF THE DEMONIC

- "...like horses prepared for battle" shows strength and endurance. This is not a disorganized group, but a well-prepared army.
- "Something like golden crowns on their heads" shows they will succeed in their appointed mission.
- "...their faces were like human faces" shows intelligence and deceptive cunningness.
- "...hair like women's hair" is reminiscent of many ancient warriors who wore long hair as a symbol
 of fierceness.
- "...teeth were like lion's teeth" shows aggression and strength.
- "...chests like iron breastplates" shows they were stronger and more invincible than the Romans, whose breastplates were leather and bronze.
- "wings...like the sound of many chariots" because they are so numerous and so vast that their wings sound like an army.
- "...stingers like scorpions" shows us they will inflict excruciating pain like the sting from a scorpion, and though it is painful, this torture will not kill those who are afflicted.

RANKS OF ANGELS AND DEMONS (PROVERBS 30:27)

The repetition of "like" shows us that a literal description is most likely not intended. V. 11 tells us that they had the angel of the abyss as their king and Proverbs 30:27 tells that literal locusts have no king.

 Their king is given the name Abaddon in Hebrew and Apollyon in Greek, which simply means destruction.

SIXTH TRUMPET (REVELATION 9:13-19)

THE SECOND WOE

The sounding of the fifth trumpet brought torment, but the sixth trumpet will bring death through another demonic attack.

 A voice calls out from the four horns on the corner of the altar for the sixth angel to release the four angels bound at the Euphrates. The usage of the word bound suggests that they are most likely demons.

A DEMONIC ÁRMY WAGES WAR

Though their exact identity is not given, these four fallen angels fulfilled a very specific purpose.

 At a time chosen by God, these four powerful, high-ranking demons would lead an innumerable army of lower-ranking demons across the Euphrates to wage war against humanity.

UNIMAGINABLE LOSS AND DEVASTATION

When this demonic army is released, they will **kill a third of humanity**. If the world's population is six billion, this means two billion people will be killed.

 It has been believed throughout history that this army has been different world powers from the Soviet Union and China, but it seems most likely this devastation is inflicted by supernatural means and not by a human army.

MORE DEMONIC DESCRIPTION

With vivid, horrific imagery, John describes this demonic horde.

The tricolor breastplate seems to symbolize strength and three plagues of fire, smoke, and sulfur. Their horses spew these plagues out of their mouths and their tails are like snakes. This shows that death is all around as they ride into battle.

HARDENED HEARTS (REVELATION 9:20-21) ONE LAST CHANCE TO REPENT BEFORE IT'S TOO LATE

At the end of time, God will no longer restrain Satan and demons, allowing the demonic to give humanity a glimpse into what Hell will be like.

 In general, mankind showed no signs of repentance despite everything that transpired, and they continued in their ungodly ways.

IF GIVEN THE CHOICE ...

Humanity was unwilling to repent. They were unwilling to give up **idolatry and worship of demons** (anything that takes the place of worshipping God), **murders** (violence & hatred), **sorceries** (Gk. pharmakōn; intoxication & drug use for pleasure & comfort), **immorality** (general term including sexual sin) and theft (dishonesty & selfishness).

THIS IS THE RESULT OF REJECTING GOD

In the end, we will see the world spiral downward into a place of materialism, murder, drug use, sexual perversion, and crime that is unparalleled in all of human history.

- When humanity rejects God, showing a desire to fulfill the evil desires of our hearts, God
 eventually gives us over to what we truly want.
- Romans 1:28 (CSB)

GUARD YOUR HEART (PROVERBS 4:23)

- Is seeking things other than God a form of escape from our current situation?
- Are we choosing things that distance us from God?
- Are we gravitating towards things that distort our ability to hear the truth and repent?
- Have we normalized sin and fallen in love with darkness so that we refuse to repent?
