

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE | Joshua 10:1-15

## **SESSION SUMMARY**

In this session, we'll dig into a story about a nation named Gibeon, who needed God's help to defeat their enemies—five kings. Through their story, we'll see how God's power is evident in impossible situations. Here are the takeaways:

- God's power is evident in our weakness (Josh. 10:1-7).
- God is our defender (Josh. 10:8-15).

## **CONVERSATION QUESTIONS**

- · How can we remind one another that we can go to God with our deepest needs?
- When has it felt like God wasn't hearing you? What are some tangible ways we can remind ourselves that God isn't ignoring us but has other plans for us instead?
- Which is our family's typical pattern: difficult situations draw us closer to God and together, or difficult situations draw us away from God and each other?

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

Invite each family member to think of something he or she really needs to bring before God in prayer this week. Then, popcorn pray for each request. Praying together helps us remember that God hears us and wants us to come to Him in our weakness, so we can boldly ask for what we need.
