# THIS WEEK'S MESSAGE

FEBRUARY 9TH, 2025 // HEBREWS

## REST (HEBREWS 4:1-11) THEREFORE

Whenever we see "therefore," we need to ask, "What is it there for?" This is to equip us with context, so we don't accidentally distort Scripture (and we can identify when someone else does).

When we approach the Bible, we need to be humble and let it tell us what it is saying.

### PROMISE

The writer just got done talking about Israel's wandering for 40 years before they entered into the promised land, how their hearts were hardened, and how they didn't listen to God.

Usually it's not massive events that make disbelief, but a **slow drift** without the anchor of **prayer** and Scripture.

# FALLEN SHORT

The writer wants these people to know that they have not fallen short, they are saved, and they are Christians.

We all need encouragement. We all have moments of doubt and we need to guench them with truth. We need to be reminded that God calls us by our name; the enemy call us by our sin.

### ISWORE

This is Psalm 95, written several decades after Israel, led by Joshua, fought and was given the promised land. Yet they are still warned that they can harden their hearts. This shows God's rest is not given by earthly blood. The rest God gives is not a physical gift but a spiritual gift. MAKE EVERY EFFORT

Knowing this, the readers are told about a Sabbath offered now, not at the end of our lives or at the end of the week. It is offered to everyone by the gospel.

So is this works based gospel? Nope. No one earns grace, so that no one may boast (Ephesians 2:8–9). Yet there still needs to be an effort of surrender.

## SHARPER (HEBREWS 4:12-13) LIVING

The Word of God is one of the greatest miracles God has ever done: 66 books, over 1,500–2,000 years, by over 40 authors, which are completely interwoven and without error or contradiction.

He did this for us so we can get to know and gain a deeper understanding of what the Spirit is telling us to do.

### **EFFECTIVE**

The Bible is not a book of morals and how to live a better life. It's a book with a purpose: not how to be Holy, but how to live once someone has become Holy through the blood of Jesus.

Holiness is not moralism. It is when we have been set apart for God and now our very being is for God.

# DOUBLE EDGED SWORD

Some like to use this to say that the Bible is given to Christians to be a weapon for their personal agenda, which is not the case.

It is more like a surgery tool that never dulls. We use it to inspect ourselves for error and sin, and expose it now so we won't be exposed later.

# HIGH PRIEST (HEBREWS 4:14-16)

# PRIESTS

They would be the ones who would perform the sacrifices, and the High Priest would enter into the Place of Meeting in the temple to receive any revelation and represent Israel before God on their behalf.

Now Jesus is on the throne representing us.

# GREAT HIGH PRIEST

Knowing everything that is done will be judged by God can be terrifying, especially when someone properly examines themselves. This is why the writer wants us to know that the one judging us knows us.

We do not serve a distant God; He lives in us, and works through us.

In humility, God the Son took on flesh and was tempted. God experienced temptation, not for bragging rights, or to lord it over us, or to gain anything, except for us.

By Him experiencing temptation we have someone who understands what it is like to go through life.

# APPROACH

God's temptation creates a boldness in Believers to approach Him because it is much more comfortable to go to someone with a problem who knows what it's like.

God is wanting us to draw near Him, desiring to give us rest, and He will go as deep as we want.

### **EFFORT**

- When we become Christians we need to hold on to Jesus knowing that He will always give us rest.
- Salvation is a completely free gift, but it is not cheap.
- When we follow Jesus we never know where it will take us, but we know the reward.

### HOLY

- When we become a Believer, we gain a purpose greater than any job, position, family, or dream
- We become a child of God, more than an overcomer, and co-heir with Jesus.
- We become a holy people who have died to their sin and are alive in Christ.
- The Bible tells us how to be that.

### THRONE

- Jesus set the example and showed that **we don't have to give in to our sin**.
- He is interceding for us, and knocking on the door of our hearts.
- **Are we doing the same** for our family, friends, and community?
- If any of us are searching for the truth, we will find it.
